- Introduction:
 - Central Theme: God’s Kingdom purposes cannot be bound by human rebellion or resignation.
1. Herod’s Violent Intentions (vv. 1-6)
 - ✓ Matthew 10:35-40, 1 Peter 5:6-8,
 2. Peter’s Miraculous Rescue (vv. 6-11)
 - ✓ Acts 5:17-21, John 21:18-19, Psalm 121:1-4, Psalm 4:5-8, Psalm 2:1-6
 3. Rhoda’s Joyous “Hospitality” (vv. 12-17)
 4. Herod’s Brutal Response (vv. 18-19)
- Conclusion:
 - Application Points:
 - a. Don’t hold back from earnest prayer for the “impossible.”
 - b. Immerse yourself in God’s past performance & future promises.
 - c. Habitually tell others of God’s present attention *to you*.
