

John 5:1-17 — “The Dangers Of False Faith”

- Introduction:

- Central Theme: It is not enough just to have faith in something; rather, one’s faith must be in Jesus to have any eternal worth.
 1. Faith placed in circumstances, luck, or good fortune is eternally bankrupt. (vv. 1-5)

 2. In any and every circumstance, what Jesus offers is far better than what the world has to offer. (vv. 6-9a)

 3. Faith-motivated obedience often leads to conflict with those who have misplaced faith. (vv. 9b-10)

 4. Faith in religion or religious behavior will lead people away from God and toward idolatry. (vv. 11-17)
