

Deuteronomy: “What Does The LORD Your God Require Of You?...” – Part 3 (Chapter 30)

- Central Theme: The relationship with God outlined in the Law for the Hebrew nation was never intended to be hopelessly frustrating or impossible—just incomplete and temporary.
1. The Law was good because it was accessible, though certainly not short. (30:11-14)
 2. The Law was good because it was straightforward, though certainly not easy. (30:15-20)
 3. The Law was good because it was hopeful, though certainly not naive. (30:1-10)
