

Small Group Sermon Response ?'s – Week of 9/28/14 Mark 5:21-43 – "More Than Miracles"

- 1. Compare and contrast Mark 5:21-23 with John 3:1-3, 16-21. What do we see of how a person must come to Jesus if he/she expects any meaningful change to take place? Consider Joe's question from the sermon: "What is it that would cause you to forfeit almost everything of value in your life and turn to Jesus?"

2. <u>Dichotomy #1: Unclean vs. Clean</u>

• Consider how Leviticus 15:25-31 relates to this passage, and answer Joe's question: "What is it in your life that makes you feel unclean or causes you to doubt whether you can be clean?"

3. Dichotomy #2: Fear vs. Faith

• Discuss the following questions: "What causes *you* fear, anxiety, and discouragement? How do Jesus' words to Jairus apply to you as well?" (Remember the three lies of Satan – "God does not know about your circumstances," "God does not care about your circumstances," and "God can not do anything about your circumstances.")

4. Dichotomy #3: Death vs. Life

- Consider Leviticus 21:10-12 and Numbers 19:11-13, and meditate on what we see of Jesus in Mark 5 when we keep these OT passages in mind.
- 5. Meditate on Joe's challenge about our "confessional theology" overlapping with our "functional theology."
- 6. Evaluate this statement from the sermon: "Jesus does not want our amazement, but our affection; Jesus does not want our wonder, but our worship; Jesus does not want our fanfare, but our faith."
- 7. Identify the "thread" that holds the whole passage together—the thread that will also hold us together through all the storms of life...
- 8. What other reflections, questions, or evaluation do you have regarding the sermon? What have you seen of God, yourself, the gospel, and/or the life of faith? What has God been teaching you in your own personal study lately?
