

John 5:30-47—“Who Is Jesus To You?”

- Introduction:

- Central Theme: Humanity must accept the Scriptures’ testimony about Christ as true or stand condemned..
 1. All the evidence points to Jesus’ testimony about Himself being true.
 - The testimony of John the Baptist is critical to the legitimacy of Jesus’ ministry.
 - The Father’s testimony is the most important evidence for the identity of The Son.
 - The Scriptures declare that Jesus is the Messiah.
 - Moses testifies that Jesus is the Messiah.

 2. To reject the witnesses to the identity of Christ is to stand condemned.
 - A rejection of The Son is a rejection of The Father.
 - A rejection of The Son is a rejection of the Scriptures.
 - A rejection of The Son springs from an earthly focus.
